PARKING PERMIT ELIGIBILITY NOTICE

Class of 2025,

Student parking at Masco during school hours is by permit only. If you are an incoming senior who is interested in obtaining a parking permit for the 2024-25 school year, please note the following.

Student parking is limited, permits are issued on a first come first served basis. You are encouraged to come to one of the early registration periods with your completed permit application. As an incoming senior, we encourage your personal responsibility. Applications must be submitted by the applicant(student); they will not be accepted from friends or family members.

Early registration periods have been spread out to be as accommodating as possible. They will be at the Link Door (Door 29) on the following dates and times;

Wednesday August 14th from 7:30 AM-9:30 AM <u>and</u> Friday August 23rd from 7:30 AM-9:30 AM, or until permits run out.

If you can't attend one of the early registration periods, applications will be accepted on Wednesday September 4th, from 6:30 AM to 8:00 AM & 2:00 PM-3:00 PM at the Safety and Security Office, or until permits run out.

The application form is attached. Hard copies can be obtained at the main office or the Safety and Security Office.

IMPORTANT! Permits will only be issued to seniors in good standing. The following will result in parking being denied:

- Unpaid student obligations. You must have a zero balance prior to submitting your parking application.
- Student can't be on social probation.
- Student parking record. If student had excessive parking violations or parked on a no parking/blackout date prior to senior year.
- No learner permits accepted. Valid MA driver's license only. **NOTE:** If road test is completed, a copy of permit signed off by an RMV Official will be accepted until the regular license is mailed to student.
- Incomplete application.
